



2017 Calcutta Explanation for Derby Contestants

The "Calcutta" is a betting process where you're betting your boat to win against the other teams/boats entered in the derby. The "top" two boats are the winners. When you first register, you have the first right to purchase (\$100) your boat in the Calcutta. If you opt out of the Calcutta at the time of registration (July 31 deadline) your boat will be available at the Salmon Derby Banquet, August 24th, from 5:00 – 6:30. Don't miss out on this opportunity to purchase/bet on your own boat. We have changed the sale of the boats this year because of "time restraints" with the derby dinner.

Winners in the Calcutta often get to split winnings of \$800 and more.

One half of the money raised through the Calcutta goes into our Derby fund to be used for Conservation and Restoration of streams and rivers in the Rogue basin.

70% of half goes to the first place team bidder

30% of half goes to the second place team bidder
